KATA

Groups by grade, boys/girls together

For medal matches, if two katas are listed, the competitor must perform a higher or lower kata appropriate for their next KYU grade. Competitors perform kata separately. The kata competition will be conducted using a flag system. With three referees. Teams can be made up with boys and girls mixed.

IPPON KUMITE, KIHON KUMITE

CODE	Competition Events	Grade
IK	IPPON KUMITE 2-4-6	Up to 5. KYU
KK	KIHON KUMITE 1-2-5	4. KYU and above
DKK	KIHON KUMITE 1-5-7	DAN grades

The demonstration of the kumite is continuous, alternating. For example, the first attacker becomes the defender, then attacker again. Not twice back and forth! Flag judging, with three referees. Teams can be made up mixed too with boys and girls, female or male together.

Shiko dachi

CODE	Children's Grade (no KYU grades) must be under 11 years of age
SHD1	Beginner White belts
SHD2	4 months experience
SHD3	5-8 months experience
SHD4	practiced for more than a year

Two competitors, boys and girls together, perform 10 junzuki, jodan uke, gedan barai on count simultaneously, next to each other in the center of the tatami, facing the chief referee. The

competitors bow at the edge of the tatami, then step onto the line with a few steps. After another bow, musubi, then yoi dachi follows. On the chief referee's command "KAMAE TE!", they step out to the side with the left leg in shiko dachi, left hand chudan zuki. After the ten zuki, uke (kiai on every tenth!), they stand up on the command "YAME" and wait for the referee's decision, then bowing and leaving the tatami. Bow to each other, shake hands.

KUMITE Sponge ball Kumite Girls:

Sponge ball Kumite Boys:

CODE	Children's Grade (no KYU grades) must be under 11 years of age
BSK1	Beginner White belts
BSK2	4 months experience
BSK3	5-8 months experience
BSK4	practiced for more than a year

Sponge ball kumite: the match duration is two minutes running time, mandatory protective gear is not required. Score - Ippon is attaching a sponge ball with velcro onto the opponents vest. Matches are fought with 2 Sponge ball piece per person. Most points win.

WKF kumite with modifications - One main referee with two flag referees. 2 minutes of clean time. Grapping in takedown is allowed.

TEAM KUMITE – Since this event is focused on the Next Generation, teams should be made up with 1 adult 18+, 1 junior and 1 cadet member. Max two teams per nation/squad/Dojo.

JUKUREN kumite 1 minute running time, three flag referees, decision at the end of the match, no scoring.

Mandatory protective gear for all kumite events WKF/JUKUREN U18: mouthguard, instep/shin guards, seiken protector, for female competitors chest protector. Use of other protective gear is permitted upon request. Round robin for up to 3 participants. Mandatory for JUKUREN kumite 18+ and 40+ is the mouthguard and for the female competitors chest protector. For male competitors groin protectors are suggested.

The organizers reserve the right to combine categories depending on the number of entries to give the best competition experience.

Entries:

We made a spreadsheet form for eliminating as many errors possible for the entries. The spreadsheet will have extra details. In case of too many entries in one category these details will help us to divide up categories for better competition.

Competitors can enter without Wado Academy passports, as long as their club is affiliated with Wado Academy. This is the responsibility of the country's chief instructor to make sure.
